
Proper Cuts






Auxin




Types of Cuts


- Heading Cut An internodal cut to a lateral bud or between growing points reserved typically for young tree training, shrubs and hedges.
- Reduction Cut A cut made to reduce a branch back to a smaller one that is also large enough to assume terminal growth.
- Branch Removal Cuts made to remove entire branches from trunk.

Branch Angle




When

 Generally, deciduous and evergreen plants should be pruned in the late winter or early spring, before growth starts.




