Founded by Paul Harris in 1905, Rotary is an organization of business and professional people united worldwide who provide humanitarian service for local and international communities, encourage high ethical standards, and help build goodwill and peace throughout the world. "Service Above Self" is Rotary's motto.

The CWR Club meets the first Wednesday of each month at Noon at The Wilkins Township Community Center, 110 Peffer Road, Turtle Creek, PA 15145. No meetings are held in July. Meal cost is \$20.00: includes meal, non-alcoholic beverage, dessert and gratuity and is paid by cash or check at the meeting.

Rotary International Dues: \$65.00 semi-annually (billed in January and July).

Rotary is a service organization. Membership in the CWR Club carries the responsibility of active service which includes regular attendance at monthly meetings and on-going participation in support of club projects and fundraisers.
